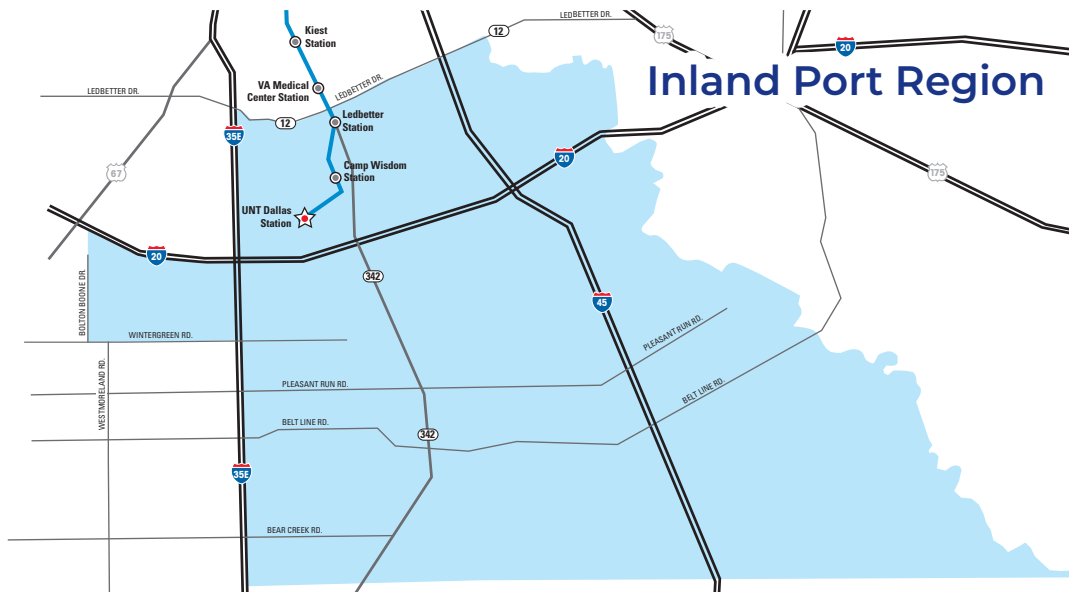

The association's newest offering is GoLink Inland Port Connect, an on-demand service providing convenient, curb-to-curb transportation in the area. The new service operates out of DART's UNT Dallas Station, for connections to DART Rail and buses. In early 2021, new evening and overnight coverage will allow your employees to travel outside of GoLink's normal operating hours.
